## 4. OUR PROGRAMS

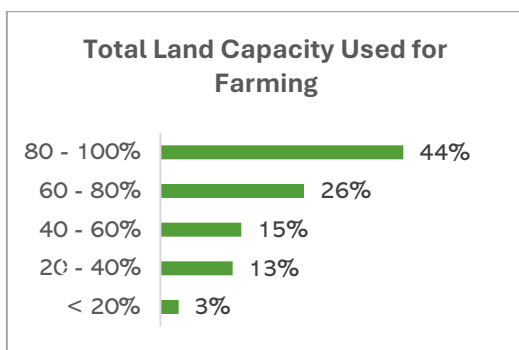
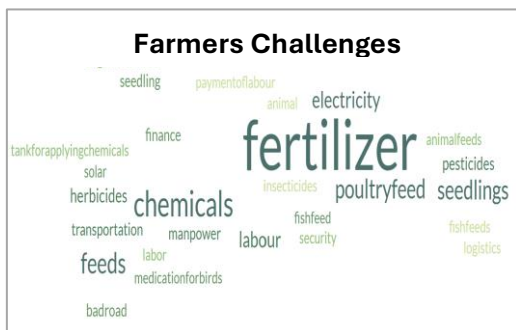
In Q2 2024 EverGreen conducted **Farm Consultations and Development Dialogue** with several farmers in Keffi and Kuje, Nasarawa State. The assessments included knowledge, operations, finance, market, and sustainability; and resulted in the creation of target development initiatives.

Q3 2024 saw the launch of EverGreen and AFAN's first program. We jointly designed and delivered a **Capacity Building Program** for over 100 farmers in Karu, Nasarawa. The multi-phased program included a needs assessment, focus group discussions, and training on sustainable farming and farm financing.
