
EverGreen is a non-profit agricultural development firm committed to the sustainable transformation of the agriculture sector in Nigeria.

Intervention Program (Needs Based)

In collaboration with our partners, we are engaging in the following three (3) pilot programs in Nasarawa State to directly impact over 300 farmers.

Input Program

Collaborating with organisations to subsidize farming inputs.

Capacity Training Program

Practical sessions including farm demonstrations with agronomist.

Poultry Program

Converting farm waste to poultry feed.

Scaling for Impact

Through our train-the-trainer model and strategic partnerships, we intend to scale our reach to **1,000 farmers** by 2026.

Monitoring Matters

We adapt good industry Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) tools for tailored tracking of the social, economic, and environmental impacts of our work.

This includes tracking key indicators against agreed baseline and frequency towards valuable targets.
